Status: Graduating high school this year and enrolled in a trade school, 2-year, or 4-year college/university this fall

Cumulative GPA: 2.75 or Higher

Attendance: 95% Minimum, Excluding Excused Absences

School: Attending a high school or technical school in one of WEPCO's five-county area: Allegany and Garrett in MD, and Mineral, Preston, and Tucker in WV

Recommendations: 2 letters of recommendation that show how students exemplify one of WEPCO's core values:

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

One letter must be from a *person working within the school*.

One letter must be from a *person within the local community*.

Curriculum: You may be enrolled in any program/curriculum or still deciding.

Continuation: The award only applies one-time.

Membership: All students may apply without having to join WEPCO.

Acceptance Letter: The recipient will be notified to provide an acceptance letter from their college, university, or trade school before they can receive the award. Otherwise, they will be disqualified.

III. How to Apply

Documents: Submit the following documents back to the guidance counselor:

1. WEPCO Scholarship Application
2. 2 Letters of Recommendation

The contact person will pick up all applications after the deadline.

Deadline: April 15, 2023

IV. Winners

Selection: One winner from each school will be selected based on an evaluation of the documents received.

Date: April 30, 2023
